If you could please inform your tenants that the charities are in need of the following:

1. **Center for Work Education and Employment**
2. **Colorado Coalition for the Homeless** – Have 600-700 Families; Need 300 toys (prefer educational toys, games, books), Winter clothing (boots, coats, etc...) and Personal Care items.
3. **Champa House**
4. **The Delores Project** - 65 women (ages 18+); Need gloves, hand warmers, personal care items and McDonalds/Starbucks gift cards in small amounts (\$5 to \$10)
5. **Denver Children’s Advocacy Center**
6. **Denver Children’s Home** - They will have the wish lists by November 5th. **Please Note:** Folks can go on line to “adopt” a child or family

7. **Father Woody’s** – Children ages 3-15; Need toys for those ages. Adult and children’s clothing. Father Woody’s serves between 3,500–4,000 people. Over half are children. They try to give one clothing item to each adult and one toy and one clothing item to each child.
8. **Gateway Women’s Center** - Approximately 800 children, 200 are under 10 the rest are adolescence and teens, equal number of boys and girls.
9. **Jeffco Action Center** - Will take anything new or used.
10. **Mt. Saint Vincent Home** - Approximately 100 children 3-18, boys and girls, \$20.00 limit.
11. **SafeHouse Denver** - 15 children 0-17, more boys than girls, boys of all ages, girls are mostly teens. About 30 families.
12. **Toys for Tots**
13. **Visiting Nurses’ Association** - 100 toys – infants to 18 years. Blankets and new clothing needed
