## **TAP THE POWER**

Recognizing the Denver real estate community for efforts to reduce water and energy use, increase operational savings, and prepare their buildings for the future.

### HOW DOES IT WORK?

Open to all metro area office buildings and hotels of 5,000 square feet or more.

Participating buildings will enter their energy and water use using the ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager tool. Experts will be available to guide participants through this process. Consumption data for 2009 will be compared against the same data for 2008, leading to six awards (one hotel and one office building in each category):

- Super Saver – a jury awarded recognition for superior achievement in energy and water management, overcoming unique obstacles and emphasizing efficiency through no- and low-cost practices.
- Greatest Improvement in Efficiency – recognizing the greatest percentage gain in energy and water performance ratings.
- Most Efficient Building – recognizing the overall highest energy and water performance rating.



### WHAT DO I GET OUT OF IT?

All participants will gain benefits and recognition from the program:

- Press release announcing all participating buildings
- Listing on the Watts To Water website
- Additional media coverage and public exposure as the program develops
- Free technical support from ENERGY STAR technicians
- Free online review of benchmarking data
- Unbiased ranking of their building's energy efficiency with a report detailing overall market ranking
- Opportunity to attend educational workshops and learn how to cut consumption even further
- Attendance at award presentation event
